

Tree Of Friends

The Tree Of Friends is a special fundraising project of the Friends of the Glendale Public Library. A Leaf, Acorn or Stone plaque is placed on the Tree to honor the contributor or anyone whom the contributor designates. The Friends invite individuals, families, businesses and organizations to become contributors and support the Library, Arts & Culture Department.

The Tree has been used as a way to celebrate someone's accomplishments, to remember a loved one, or as a statement about someone's interest in the Library/reading/etc.

Contributions are tax deductible and begin at \$500 for a Leaf, \$1000 for an Acorn, and \$2500+ for Stones. For more information call (818) 548-2030 or see Library Administration on the 2nd floor of the Central Library.

The Tree Of Friends is located next to the BookNook bookstore at the Central Library. It holds 200 brass leaves that are screwed into eight $\frac{3}{4}$ inch clear Lucite plates. There are figurative branches and a trunk made of a gnarled-looking dark brass.

Leaves can be purchased \$500 or \$1,000. Acorns and Stones that hang on the wall around the Tree may be purchased for \$2,000, \$5,000 and \$10,000. Each item is inscribed according to the wishes. Acorns and leaves may be installed by the Friends for significant in-kind donations or services. We offer time-payment plans.
